Tracy Byrd

Game on Sports Bar in Conroe is starting a series of high profile concerts on Friday, March 25. The first concert will be headlined by Tracy Byrd. Jody Booth, a headliner at many area venues, is opening the show. Here is info we have gathered on Tracy Byrd and Jody Booth from their internet resources.

Tracy Byrd's brand of new traditionalist country made him a star in the '90s, particularly his playful, good-time party singalongs (though he also turned in the occasional ballad success). Byrd was born in the small rural town of Vidor, Texas, in 1966 and grew up listening to his family's extensive country record collection. When Byrd was 20 years old, he visited a novelty recording studio in a shopping mall and sang over a karaoke-style backing track of "Your Cheatin' Heart." Impressed, the saleswoman invited him to perform in an amateur talent show, and when Byrd was well received, he decided to make country music his vocation. He dropped out of college and joined Mark Chesnutt's band, eventually replacing Chesnutt as the house headliner at a popular nightspot in Beaumont, Texas. He made one unsuccessful trip to Nashville in search of a record deal, but his second time around, he landed a private audition with MCA executives, who signed him right away.

Byrd's self-titled debut album was released in 1993, and while it wasn't a blockbuster, it put the singer on the map in a big way with its third single, the number one smash "Holdin' Heaven." The follow-

up album, 1994's *No Ordinary Man*, was Byrd's commercial breakthrough; it sold over two million copies thanks to four Top Five hits: the dance tunes "Watermelon Crawl," "Lifestyles of the Not So Rich and Famous," and "The First Step," and the change-of-pace ballad "The Keeper of the Stars," which became a wedding favorite among country fans. Byrd followed his big success quickly with 1995's *Love Lessons*, and while singles like "Walking to Jerusalem" and "4 to 1 in Atlanta" didn't duplicate the massive popularity of their predecessors, they still helped the album sell at a respectable gold level. 1996's *Big Love* returned Byrd to the Top Five of the singles charts with the title track and "(Don't Take Her) She's All I Got," and the title track of 1998's *I'm from the Country* reached similar territory.

Byrd subsequently decided to leave MCA for RCA, and made his label debut with 1999's *It's About Time*, which featured a smoother, more pop-like production on tracks like the near-Top Ten "Put Your Hand in Mine" (the record's biggest single). However, Byrd returned to straight-ahead, good-time country for the follow-up,

2001's *Ten Rounds*; fans rewarded him by sending the single "Ten Rounds with Jose Cuervo" to the top of the charts, giving Byrd his second number one. The album also featured the Top Ten hit "Just Let Me Be in Love" and a duet with Chesnutt on the playfully anti-pop "A Good Way to Get on My Bad Side." A final album for RCA, *Truth About Men*, appeared in 2003. Byrd then released *Different Things* on Blind Mule Records in 2006. An acoustic mix of the album was issued by the label two years later in 2008.

Jody Booth, from Livingston, Texas

headlines shows about 15 times a month and has opened for the likes of Willie Nelson, Merle Haggard, Tracy Lawrence, Aaron Watson, Jack Ingram and Roger Creager. His last album was 2008's *Heaven and Hell*. He is currently working on a third album.

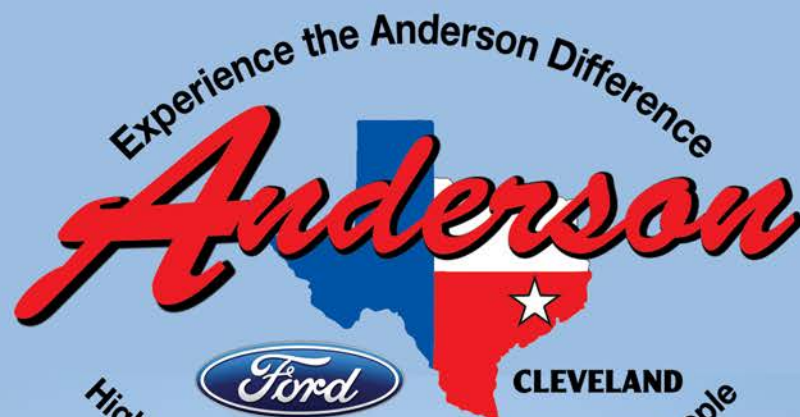

SOUNDS what a long, strange trip . . .

I am pinch writing for Dave Miller again. As some of you know, Dave's beloved wife, Peggy passed away recently. I am sure Dave doesn't mind me calling Peggy the better half of the Dave and Peggy Good-Time Traveling Show column, which has been a staple in this magazine for over 20 years. Dave plans to dedicate a column to Peggy soon and is planning a big musical tribute in the near future at a local club. Look for details in the April issue.

With Peggy's passing and Jay Martin's death a couple of months ago, coupled with the deaths of music icons David Bowie, Glen Frey and Paul Kantner of the Jefferson Airplane (a personal favorite of mine from a favorite band), the last three months have not been the best

in my musical world. It made me think back to the very first issue of North of the Border, which we dedicated to Stevie Ray Vaughan, who had died in an airplane crash right before we went to the printer. All of our magazines have been recently organized and archived, prompting me to look through the early issues.

The first issue was published in September of 1990. The magazine was all in black and white and featured a collage cover that featured 13 photos that included Larry Butler, Ray Benson, the sign at the old Banana Bay (which is now Wolfies on Lake Conroe), Rock-a-Billy's (which is now a MarineMax), Tampico Bay Beach Club (now the Concert Pub North), Willie Nelson's Night Life (now a Hispanic club on FM 1960) and the legendary Wunsche

Brothers Café, which recently had a significant fire and is now closed.

We thank God for the first advertisers who had the courage to write a check and allow us to publish our first 12 pages. The first ever advertiser was Hubba Dub's, a bar and grill and the self-proclaimed "Home of the Original Mother Rucker", a giant home-made hamburger. The ad was sold by a guy named Bernie McCrary and it was the only ad he ever sold! Other ads were sold to a fitness center, a scuba shop, a photo shop and the Encore Record Shop, which did several album reviews. Clubs that advertised included Banana Bay, which had Ezra Charles and

the Works, Pierre and the Zydeco Dots, Zen Archer and Kevin Black. Rock-a-Billy's had just opened and had Johnny Dee and the Rocket 88's and Earlywine, who are still performing in the area today. We had an article about a new (and now long-gone) wild life park and I did high school football picks. There was an ad for a benefit for the first Conroe Cajun Catfish Festival, which made its debut the next month in November.

In our ninth issue, "The Music Store That Ate My Brain", The Texas Music Emporium bought its first ad. TME has run in every issue since, and TME is our longest-running advertiser. That is more than 25 years and 300 ads. Store owner Jim "Rod" Cappiello, whose store pre-dated these ads by at least a decade, has now announced his retirement. The store will remain open and Jim will still be around a little, but he says the seven days a week grind is over. Long time worker and fellow Rod Brother, Hugh Meyer will be the new manager.

On my most recent visit, Jim reminisced about the many decades of the Texas Music Emporium, "We have been in three locations through the years, but have been at the current FM 1960 at I-45 location for close to twenty years now. I would say the longevity of TME is mostly due to the dedication of taking care of our customers. I still have people come in that did business with us in our first couple of years.

"But we also have had a lot of fun creating our brand. I ran a lot of commercials in the glory days of Houston rock radio that took place in the eighties and early nineties, at stations like Z-Rock that actu-

ally started as an AM station and KLOL 101. We did a lot of promotions with people who became radio rock legends like Moby, Stevens and Pruett, Kevin Dorsey and Dana Steele, and of course the Miss Rockwear Competitions. We had fun with slogans like, "The First Music Store on the Moon", but the all-time great was the "Music Store That Ate My Brain". The t-shirts literally became a second business - we sold and shipped so many of them. The shirts were spotted by Jennifer Batten, who played guitar with several music stars including Michael Jackson. She had to have one! (Jennifer will be playing at The Concert Pub North on March 4).

"We also had some great clinics and parking lot concerts through the years with players like Zach Wyld and Nuno Bettencourt, just to name a couple. It will be nice to take it easy, but I still plan to stay in touch with the store, drag race and play music with The Rod Brothers."

Speaking for both Jim "Rod" and myself, and quoting The Grateful Dead, "What a long, strange trip it's been!"

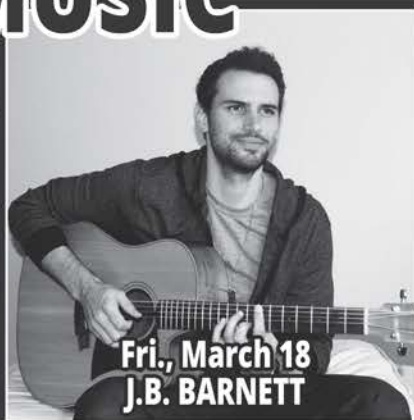

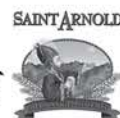

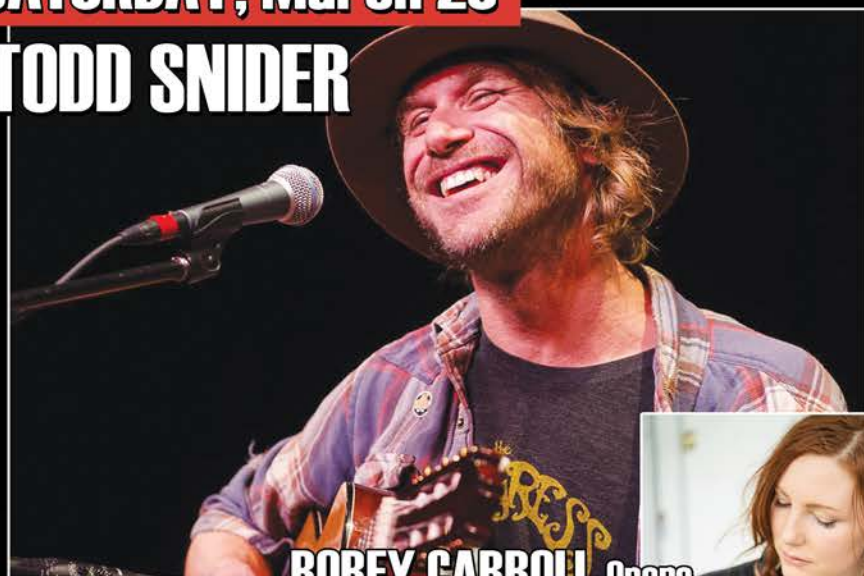
