Treynwrek Set to Release New Album, Rule of Thirds

In the 1950's and early 1960's, rock music barely existed. Almost all recordings, and the hit records that came from them, were from individual stars. For the most part, the stars recorded music written by record label staff writers. Professional musicians backed the singers and although, in fairness, the singers had talent, good looks and style counted for a lot. Even the pioneers of rock and roll like Elvis, Chuck Berry, and Little Richard were individual stars, although Berry and Richard wrote many of their hits. Buddy Holley and the Crickets were a band, but Holly sang and wrote the songs. From this came The Beatles and the decades of the revolution of the rock band, with multiple writers working within the framework of the band.

Fast forward to the 2019 Grammy Awards. I was struck by the fact that at least in the portion that was televised, there wasn't a single rock song played and all of the award winners were individuals. Have we come full circle, or is the band that wants to perform as a group that pushes the envelope still out there? That is what Treynwrek is attempting to do with their new album, *Rule Of Thirds*. The biggest challenge in the world of music has always been to get people to listen.

Treynwrek consists of Trey Dreyden on guitar and vocals, James Breaux on bass and vocals and Tim Hutto on drums and vocals. Treynwrek came together like a lot of bands. "We all attended area jams, especially the one at The Jailhouse that Charlie Parker hosted for so long," Trey says. "We discovered we had a lot in common in what we liked in music, but we also

wanted to create our own sound."

"You can hear a little bit of everything in our music," Tim says. "Rock and blues for sure, but we play with pace and power. This will be our third album and, by far, this one is an album where we all contribute. We learned a lot from the first two. Trev did most all of the writing on the first one and on the second one we added musicians and produced too much in the studio. This one we wanted it to be just the band and we wanted to capture the sound we play live. We recorded Rule of Thirds at Sunburst Recording Studios in Livingston. Brandon Fowler of Satisfied Drive worked with us on the recording."


"Although Trey has been our main

writer, all three of us chip in on each song," James says. "We have played about 140 shows a year for six years and now with the release of this album, we are ready to see how far we can go."

"We are going to have a Preview Listening Party at the Corner Pub on Wednesday, April 3," Trey says. "We are going to play the album a couple of times and people can order a copy. Then on Friday, April 19 we are going to play *Rule of Thirds* live at Acadia Bar for the CD Release Party."

Tim says the next challenge is to get their music outside of the Houston area, "We will be looking for airplay, of course. In today's world that means more than traditional commercial radio, which has always been tough for inde-

pendents. But KPFT in Houston plays us on their blues shows, plus I think college radio would dig our sound. The Internet has endless opportunities that bands have never had before. We have taken a break from shows for a couple of months to finish the album and to get a little break from all of the gigs. But we are ready to get out and start playing again. Hopefully we can play some out of the Houston area and even outside of Texas."



The thing I like about Treynwrek is that they have their own sound. I have never heard a band that sounds quite like they do. Perhaps the point of the story is there are still bands out their willing to take risks and push the envelope. You just have to know where to find them. Treynwrek Rule of Thirds

Self-Recorded

This band consists of Trey Dryden on guitar/vocals, James Breaux on bass/vocals and Tim "Wingnut" Hutto on drums/vocals. They have been playing our area for over six years, but this work of original songs really highlights the true quality of their work.

After a brief, cute intro, they get right into it with "Bad Luck", an anthem to not taking any crap, with lots of Trey's grinding axe-work. Then on "Space City Cowboy", a no-holdsbarred rocker, they revel in their Texas roots as "bad boys" taking hearts because they can, interspersed with references to the Houston area's ties to NASA. The ominous "Whispers on the Water" has a heavier sound and a bit of voodoo in the bayou, adding to its mystery. Slowing it down a lot, "Creeper" tells a tale of "moving on" from what they had. Picking it back up, "Good Bad Girl" packs a wallop with some pretty cool lyrics and loads of cool guitar licks. The soul-searching "Whiskey Problems" weaves a tale of how "whiskey don't treat me like it used to" and asks a lot of questions (works like that on me, too!). The also-dark "Maelstrom" asks about "the elephant in the room" and has some pretty heavy ideas looming around it. In another nod to their Texas roots,



"Don't Touch My Hat" or "I'll kick your ass", and a host of other things I can't print here, but a slick song, and it hits the mark. More Texas lore surfaces in "Outlaw Josey Wales" with it's tale of running from the law and "don't you ever look back" as the story-line ends with "guns blazing" (nice sound effects, guys), like the movie. The final cut, "Lori's Lullaby" is a fitting finale to this great piece of work, as a loving tribute to drummer Tim "Wingnut" Hutto's late wife, a tear-jerker but beautiful song.

This is a work of art, well-mixed and crystal clear that showcases the talent of this band, and the songwriting is top-notch. Most of you have seen them play and love these guys, but this is really the icing on the cake.

Treynwrek will have a listening and pre-order party for *Rule of Thirds* at The Corner Pub on Wednesday, April 3 and a CD Release Party at Acadia Bar on Friday, April 19.


