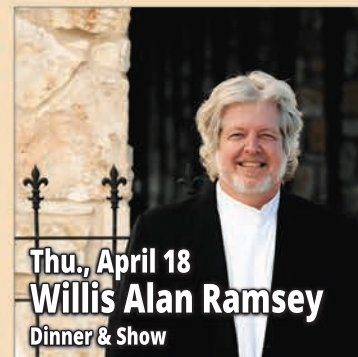

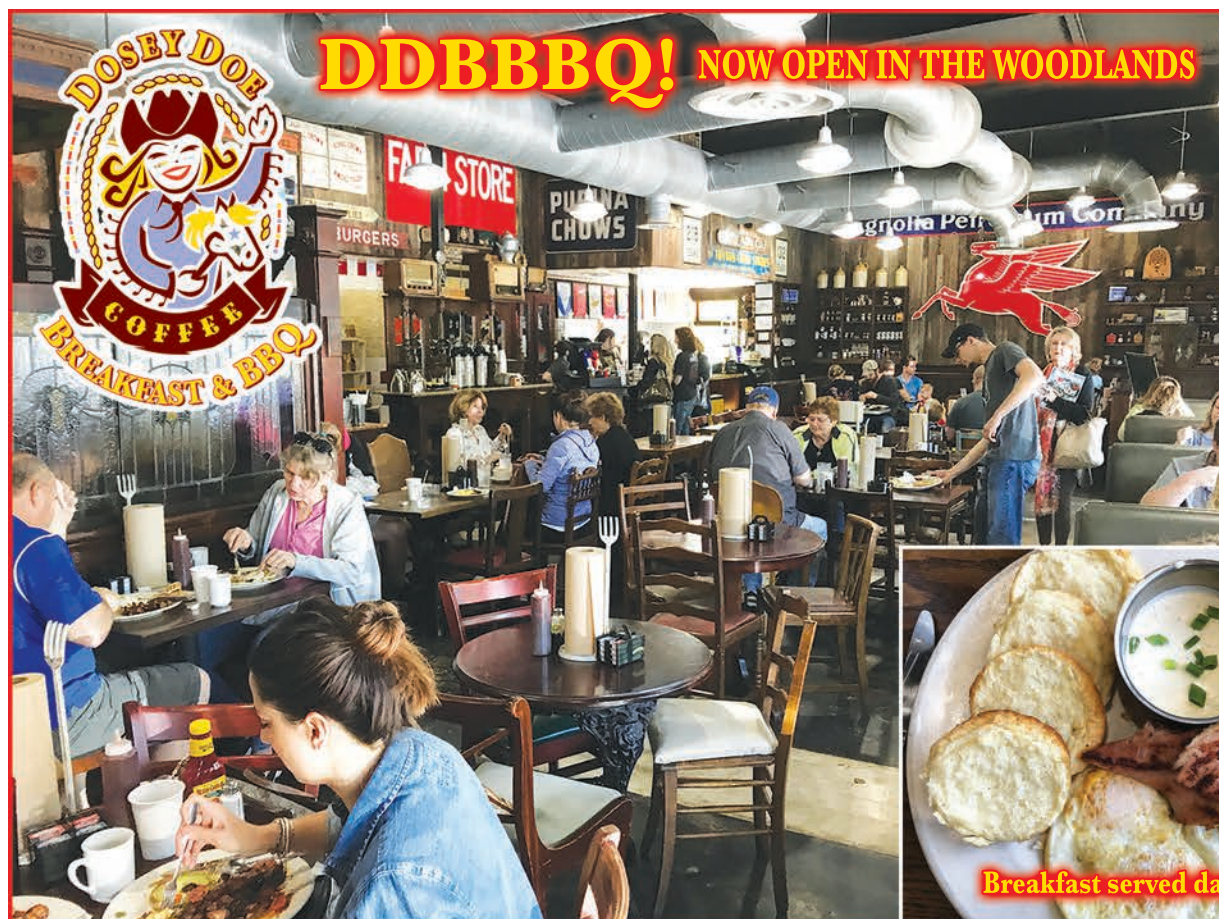

# COVER STORY

## James Henry, Texas Blues Guitarist

Texas blues guitarist James Henry has been called “Houston’s best kept secret” for years. I listened to James multiple times in his first band, The Shadowcasters back in the day and they were one of my favorite young bands. Now a quarter of a century later, I caught up with James and relived his busy career with him.

“I got my start at the age of 17 when I met and was mentored by Houston music legend Jerry Lightfoot and eventually started playing with him,” said James. “I also began playing the regional blues circuit with Pearl Murray, beginning in 1993. I then formed the band Shadowcasters, who were mainstays on the blues scene from 1993 to 2011 and we ultimately released one album, *It Takes Time*, in 2002.”

The original Shadowcasters featured an excellent vocalist, Jim McLellon, the late great Dan Workman on bass and Dennis Lawson on drums.

After being a sideman and band member of groups for over two decades, James stepped out on his own

with the 2014 release of his aptly titled debut album, *Live Album*, on Molken Music. *Live Album* is a blisteringly intense blues guitar smackdown, recorded at the For the Community Festival 7 at Last Concert Café in Houston in February of 2014. Backing James is rhythm section Thurman Robinson on bass and Mike Morris (of C.J. Chenier fame) on drums. The *Houston Chronicle’s* main music writer, Andrew Dansby gave the album an excellent review.

“I also played guitar for blues artist Steve Krase, filling the guitar spot for the past ten years playing hundreds of shows at clubs and festivals across the U.S. and in Europe, as well as playing guitar on the group’s three album releases *Easy Living*, *Someday*, and *Buckle Up* (which reached #3 on the Billboard blues charts). While playing with Steve Krase, I backed up many blues artists such as Trudy Lynn and Big Walter Price, ‘The Thunder Bird.’ In 2012 James also took home the 2012 ‘Houston’s Best Guitarist’ award in the *Houston Press*. As if all of this

wasn’t enough to keep James busy, he also played guitar in the reformed version of the Texas psychedelic band, The Golden Dawn, led by George Kinney. (Their lone album was released by International Artists in 1968.)

As part of these bands listed above, James has opened for many major artists over the last 20 years, including: Bobby “Blue” Bland, Ian Moore, Delbert McClinton,

Jerry Lacroix, Nick Gravenites, Chris Duarte, Johnny Winter, Pat Travers, Ray Price, Johnny Lee, and Roy Head.

James has his own albums, plus several of the albums from bands he has worked with, available on his website. His latest CD release is *Live Electrolux*, recorded at the Electrolux Festival in Houston in September, 2016. His original *Live Album* from 2012 is available on randomly-mixed color vinyl LPs and comes with a free download card containing links for the entire album in both CD-res WAV files and 320 kbps MP3 files, album artwork, and an exclusive, bonus ambient track. Also available is a 2016 compilation of previously unreleased live recordings by The Shadowcasters, *Between the Light and Dark*.

I asked James to look back on his 26 years in the music business and into the future. He said, “When I was young of course, I had plenty of wild energy when I played. But as I have

matured, I have learned to be more efficient and to shape my shows to what a particular audience would like to hear. Time goes by so quickly. I have concerns about younger people today and in some cases their inability to relate to live music. If I personally find my commercial success, of course that would be great, but I will continue to play mainly for the love of the music and the truth it can tell. Besides playing shows, I am working hard on two new records.”

The musicians working with James now and on his new records are Michael Morris on drums and Thurman Robinson on bass. Musicians who also play with James Henry are James Moore on drums and Quentin Calva on bass.

James will be playing a show at Backwoods Saloon on Friday, April 19.

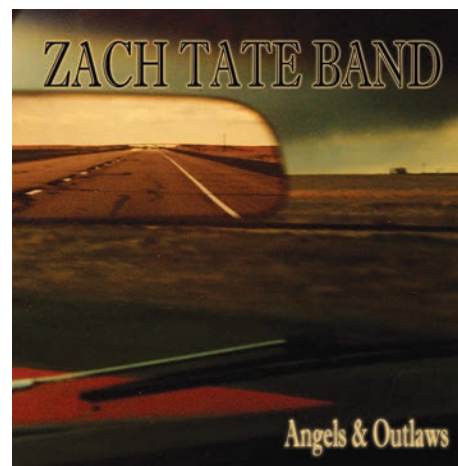
This band is back with a group of tunes that range from a statement on a recent event to tear-shedding lost loves. The band is Zac on guitar/vocals/harmonica, Lynn Raggio on lead guitar/vocals, Gary Graham on keyboards, Drew

Schuessler on bass and Jody Smith on drums. The opening track, "Outlaw" is the story of the Waco, Texas/ Twin Peaks shootout in 2015 between rival motorcycle clubs -the Bandidos and the Cossacks - and Waco Police, and is comprised of powerful and sometimes-disturbing live footage from police and news cameras at the gunfight as well as a series of classic, 1960's, black and white outlaw biker photographs by Danny Lyon. The 6-minute heavy ballad is a raw, stunning demonstration of the Zach Tate Band's ability to tell an intimate story as an arena-rock anthem and offers insight and follow-up to one of the most deadly motorcycle club-police shootouts in U.S. history. A less serious tale is "Reverend Jack & His Roamin' Cadillac Church", a catchy cut with "all backseat drivers". The "Moonlight Kiss" takes us to the bayou where "the Voodoo rule the snake" and things are sometimes strange. The tale of love lost and found is told on "Rescue Me" and on "Summer Night Special", a bouncy tune about drinking

beer and making love. He slows it down on "In A Song", a romantic ode, and then picks it up on "Butterfly", about a love he lost. He continues the trend of lost love in "Still In Love With You", a heart-rending ballad, and a feeling many of us have had in a relationship on "You Drive Me Crazy", one of my favorite cuts. He starts your toe tapping with the fun cut, "Bring On The Whiskey", about someone driving him to drink (been there, done that), and really ramps it up on "The Wedding Song" about some wild flings he's had. The sorrowful "Fiddlers Green" is a sad refrain and will bring a tear to your eye, my favorite cut. The final cut "Angel (The Space In Between)" completes the theme of broken hearts. Sounds like someone needs a shoulder to cry on. This is a well-crafted album with a nice variety of themes and very appealing sound. Highly recommended! ## The Wooden Spoke - More Than BBQ

Probably most of us have been driving the backroads and seen a little restaurant or cafe and wondered about how the food and service

would be. You would really be in the middle of nowhere if you stumbled across The Wooden Spoke, which is adjacent to the Whiskey Tango Bar in Grimes County. If you did decide to stop and eat, you would be justly rewarded.

Actually, The Wooden Spoke is not too far from the site where the Texas Renaissance Festival is located. The Wooden Spoke is currently not a large place and has no indoor seating, but there are some outdoor seats. They are planning to expand soon to create

an indoor dining room area. A lot of customers order food to be delivered to the adjacent Whiskey Tango Bar, where you can order your choice of beverage.

Although the Wooden Spoke is small, the menu certainly isn't. The main menu features about 40 items highlighted by the Barbecue Plates. The owner, "Big" Mike Gray, who some might know from his earlier Wooden Spoke restaurant location on FM 2978, takes great pride in preparing the barbecue and has won several

awards for his efforts. He told me, "We cook the brisket for 14 hours at low temperature, dry rub the ribs and slowly dry rub the chicken with seasoning. The sausage is a premium brand we get from College Station and

I have found none better. We won major barbecue competitions in Houston in 2008 and in Conroe in 2014."

But there is more than barbecue at the Wooden Spoke. They have burgers, chicken strips and steak

fingers, Chicken Fried Steak, sandwiches and giant BBQ stuffed potatoes, among other items. There is a large and varied selection of appetizers including fried mushrooms, jalapeño poppers, bacon wrapped zucchini or squash, Quesadillas, boudain balls and in a match made in heaven, the "Wooden Spokes" which are chicken fried bacon strips. All of the appetizers are perfect choices to eat while you enjoy a beverage at the Whiskey Tango.

I ordered the cheeseburger, which was big, old fashioned and delicious. Pixie had a BBQ Plate with brisket, chicken, green beans, buttery Texas Toast and Ranch Potatoes – chunks of cooked potatoes tossed in Ranch dressing and topped with cheese. It was quite good and a lot of food.

Whether you eat outdoors at the Wooden Spoke, next door at the Whiskey Tango, or get an order to go, you will be glad you stopped. They currently have crawfish on Sundays, Thursday is Steak Night, Fried Catfish on Fridays and \$6.00 specials on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. All of the pricing is reasonable.

You can also order barbecue by the pound,

and the Wooden Spoke is a great choice for catering.

We met the cook, Chris Costa who was very nice and helpful, and the service was friendly and efficient. The Wooden Spoke is open at 12:00 p.m. seven days a week. They are located at 15875 County Road, Navasota. The phone is 936-894-1079.

We had our meal delivered inside the Whiskey Tango, where we could enjoy it with a nice cold draft beer. There was a nice size crowd having fun in the bar on a Monday night. The Whiskey Tango has a lot of good live music every weekend and is having Jody Booth on Saturday, April 20. 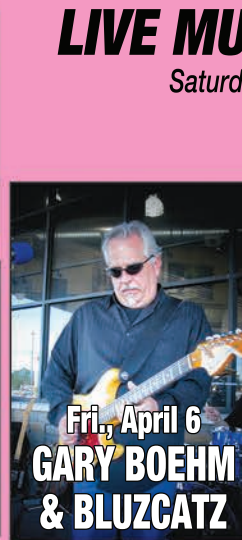
